


**HOW TO PARTICIPATE TO THE SAFARI?**

**Make your contribution in the way that suits you: you can sponsor a child or groups of children or make a donation**

**INDIVIDUAL SPONSORSHIP of a child**

**With 38 euros per month you open the door to a child's future.**

Each sponsored child receives preventive and curative health care, free schooling and legal protection. The person of his family or clan with whom he lives receives a quarterly cash allowance for overheads incurred.

With your sponsorship, your godson has the guarantee to be educated from kindergarten to university according to his abilities. Vocational training comes to the rescue of those who may become allergic to the blackboard.

**SPONSORING of the "MUTUAL INSURANCE"**

**With 24 euros per month you contribute to « PTZ Mutual », insuring the children against the odds of their journey.**

Many people with uncertain personal situation would prefer not to commit to a child for an extended period of time.

With this type of sponsorship, you ensure children against the vagaries of their journey.

Ex: For those who have unexpectedly lost their sponsor, for those in urgent need of help but for whom a sponsor has not yet been found, or for the higher costs of professional integration, higher education, serious illness, disability, etc.

**DONATIONS**

**You help where it's urgent.**

If you wish, you can support a specific component of the programme - for example women's groups or a particular vocational school, a kindergarten, a construction project, or a larger structural investment such as the equipment of a dispensary.

## Our Vocational Schools

Our 5 schools graduated at the end of November , during their Open House Day .

**All grade II students received a going-away gift to help them start their careers.**

For another year, they will be followed by Partage to facilitate their integration. A third year is possible within the premises and with the equipment of the schools to gain experience. They then participate in producing for external retail orders, assisted by their former teachers.

The Hotel Management option is an exception. Since it has been in existence, students find, as soon as they leave school, to be hired by the hotels of the region. The same goes for those who got their Montessori Diploma. As for agricultural training, it commonly leads to home installation, with one year of follow-up by our agronomists who supply inputs and small livestock (poultry, goats, pigs, hives...).

### NEW

Opened in September 2022, a 6-month course for obtaining a certificate of initiation to the psychology and the Montessori method, is delivered to 20 Grade A public school teachers selected and sent to our college by the Ministry of Education. The agreement signed with the government provides that Partage trains 120 of them over three years (20 every six months).





**Fanny came to visit us in early January 2023... for the 7th time ! Over the past three years, due to Covid-19, she has been the first of our sponsors to make the trip.**

*I have known Partage Tanzania for 14 years now. I started my first sponsorship in 2009 with a boy named Daudi. I knew him when he was 10 years old and thanks to this sponsorship and the NGO on the ground, I was able to accompany him to his autonomy. He was able to study until the end of high school and then went to a vocational school to learn a trade. He now works on construction sites as a bricklayer. And... he saves on his modest salary to support his mother.*

***I think the work that Partage has put in place with the Victoria Programme is exceptional.***

*I have been to Bukoba seven times and I can see that the assistance delivered to the villages is constant: everything works perfectly, everyone has a well-defined role within the sponsorship office. It is an NGO that we can trust, that does a remarkable job with children and their families. If it was not so, it wouldn't have lasted for 33 years!*

*I now have a second godchild, Justina, that I sponsor since she was 8. I intend to continue to support her and help her so that she can go as far as possible in her studies, so that she can learn a trade and earn a living. Many children, in the poor village where she lives, may not know this chance. Tanzania's development is highly uneven; the gap between rich and poor is widening..." - Fanny G. 10/02/2023*



#### **JEREMIA**

Crushed by a truck at the age of eight, Jeremia is amputated of both legs and the left arm. His parents, poor peasants, abandoned him. A clan of street-children adopted him until a passer-by, good samaritan, moved him to school.

At the end of high school, he loses his guardian. Partage took over to let him continue at the university level. Next year he will complete a Bachelor's degree in Special Needs at the State University of Zanzibar (SUZA). The campus being huge and without transport, he needed a vehicle. The German Friends of Partage, who are funding his studies, offered him this scooter... at Christmas.

#### **CRASH**

On November 6 of last year, a PRECISION AIR ATR-500 tried to land at the small Bukoba airport during a storm. The final is flown over Lake Victoria; the threshold of the runway is on the beach. One hundred meters before touchdown, a downwash gust of wind flapped the plane in the water. 43 people on board, 19 drowned including the two pilots and one of the two stewardesses.
